

Why choose Ipswich High School

With so many UK boarding schools to choose from, why consider Ipswich High School? It is one of Suffolk's leading independent schools and boasts incredible examination results along with an unmatched Enrichment Programme and pastoral care.

What we offer

A tailored education and curriculum for every pupil.

With an incredibly wide range of GCSE and A Level subjects on offer as well as HPQ and EPQ our curriculum is vast. We offer bespoke English as an Additional Language (EAL) provision to all international pupils and tailored academic support to help you reach your full potential.

Outstanding GCSE and A Level results.

We have the highest percentage of top marks awarded at GCSE level of any school in our region and a 100% pass rate at A Level. This year, a significant 64% of GCSE results were awarded at grades 7-9 (equivalent to previous grades of A and A*), with an impressive 40% of results being awarded at grade 8-9, which are above an A grade. Our strengths are evident throughout STEM subjects but also across the arts.

Location

Our 84 acre campus provides a stunning backdrop for our pupils' education in the heart of the British countryside. The rural setting is however just a few miles from the vibrant waterfront town of Ipswich and just over an hour away from London and Cambridge by train. The school's connections make it easy for pupils to enjoy their free time at weekends and during holidays.

Boarding

Our boarding facility, 'The Dairy' has just been completely renovated and restored to the highest standards. Located in a privileged position on the school campus, The Dairy is a small home away from home, offering a wonderful environment for boarders.

Facilities

Our spacious school campus has superb facilities including a theatre, ICT suites, a 25m swimming pool, Sixth Form suite, cookery rooms, dedicated music rooms and floodlit AstroTurf pitches. Our facilities are being constantly upgraded and improved with some exciting new additions to our campus planned in the coming years.

University progression

Our pupils continue on to great things once they complete their education with us. In 2018 all of our pupils going on to university gained entry into their first choice. Past pupils have studied at Cambridge, UCL, Bristol, Imperial College London and Warwick.

Academic life

Ipswich High School welcomes international pupils from age 11 – 18, most of whom join us for GCSE or A Level study.

We pride ourselves on offering a broad and balanced curriculum through a wide array of academic subjects, and a diverse set of opportunities, available via our vast enrichment programme. This combination is certainly unique to many independent day schools, and is one that we are immensely proud of.

The aim of teaching across the school is to foster a love of learning by really engaging students in their studies and ultimately help them develop as outstanding learners. We want our pupils to be intellectually curious, ambitious, courageous, reflective, and resilient and, above all, armed with key learning skills which will help them beyond GCSEs and A Levels, for whatever choices they make.

Our GCSE results are the best in the county and we encourage pupils to focus on nine GCSE subjects to ensure they achieve strong results and a commitment to each subject studied. We also have an ambitious A Level curriculum. We work with our students to create a bespoke and tailored timetable, enabling them to move on from our Sixth Form with the most suitable qualifications and skills for whatever career path they choose. Our Sixth Form students typically study three A Levels with additional AS, GCSE and Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) options available to all.

In the Sixth Form, small class sizes (typically four to eight), university style teaching and regular assessment challenge each student throughout their A Levels whilst weekly subject clinics and easy access to teachers means support, help and advice is always there if needed.

Our Enrichment Programme also allows pupils to pursue their academic and extra-curricular interests beyond the classroom.



University and Careers

Ipswich High School careers and university preparation starts before Sixth Form, with guidance and support offered to our pupils from Year 9.

At Sixth Form, this guidance becomes more personalised and tailored to each student's individual strengths, plans and interests. Our sixth formers receive offers at their first choice (often Russell Group) universities including Oxbridge, for challenging subjects such as History of Art, Law and Medicine. However, our careers advice offers more than this 'traditional' path. We provide guidance for any course at any university in the UK, Europe or beyond.

- 4 | University application and interview process assistance.



Applying to Ipswich High School

We welcome applications for the Senior School and Sixth Form, depending on availability of places.

International students joining the school will sit formal examinations and meet the Director of Sixth Form, Head or Deputy Head for a videoconference interview. They will also be asked to provide a reference from their current school and predicted GCSE grades if applicable.

To apply, please complete the registration form.

Ipswich High School is a licenced Tier 4 sponsor and will discuss your visa requirements throughout the admissions process. Applicants seeking a Tier 4 visa must be over the age of 11 by the time they are admitted to the school and must be either a boarder or a homestay student with Ipswich High School.

Admissions Process

- Complete the registration form attached (or here: ipswichhighschool.co.uk/registration-form).
- 2 | The Registrar will arrange for testing (English and Maths) and request a report from your current school.
- 3 | Pending the testing results, we will arrange a Skype (or alternative) interview.
- 4 | After the interview, the Head will be in a position to make an offer of a place.
- **5** | We will then discuss visa applications with you.

International Scholarships

We offer Academic Scholarships and these are offered to those who excel in academia and are offered to the top performing candidates who demonstrate outstanding ability. Scholarships are prestigious and are highly valued by University Admission tutors. The accolade, kudos and sense of achievement is considerable for both the pupil and our school.

All awarded Scholarships are carried forward each year until the end of Year 13.
